Updates (TH): Access: car park restored and Phil & Jim thanked for temporary use of their car park. Imminent Railway bridge path re-surfacing was welcomed a Employees: Employers of helpers are to be advised not to allow use of members' shared equipment.

Trees: A list of trees to be felled within the site is ready for future action by David Haynes.

Boundary: A working party to trim hedges around the site's perimeter and pond banks is to be arranged.

Finance (RC): £16,000 held in our Bank account. Outstanding rents to City Council are assumed to be paid after completion of lease.

Lettings (MF): Recent plot inspection on 10th October resulted in several letters and replies to deal with neglected plots. The Day Lily collection on plot 108e has available for dispersal with the understanding of the current tenants.
